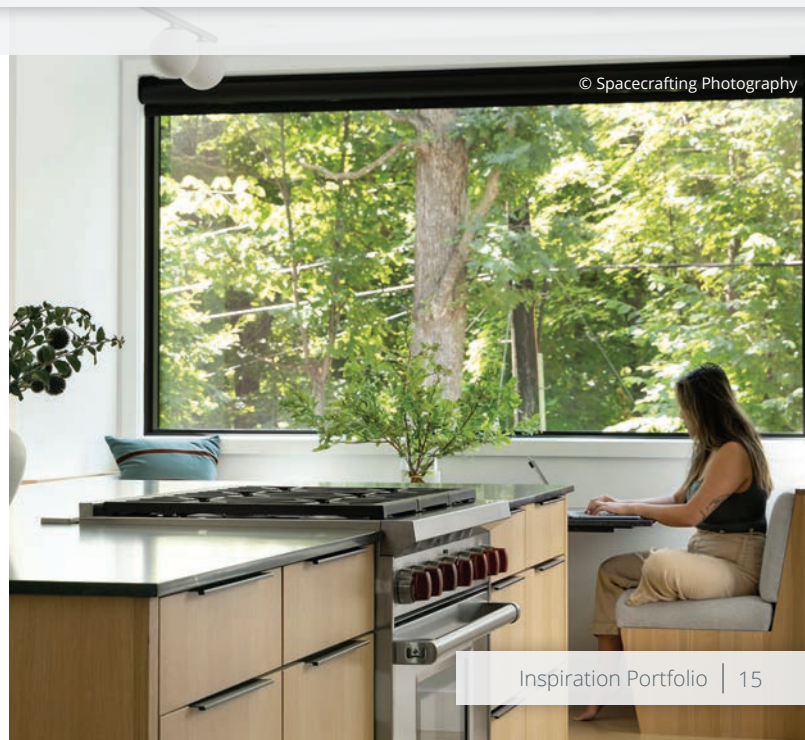
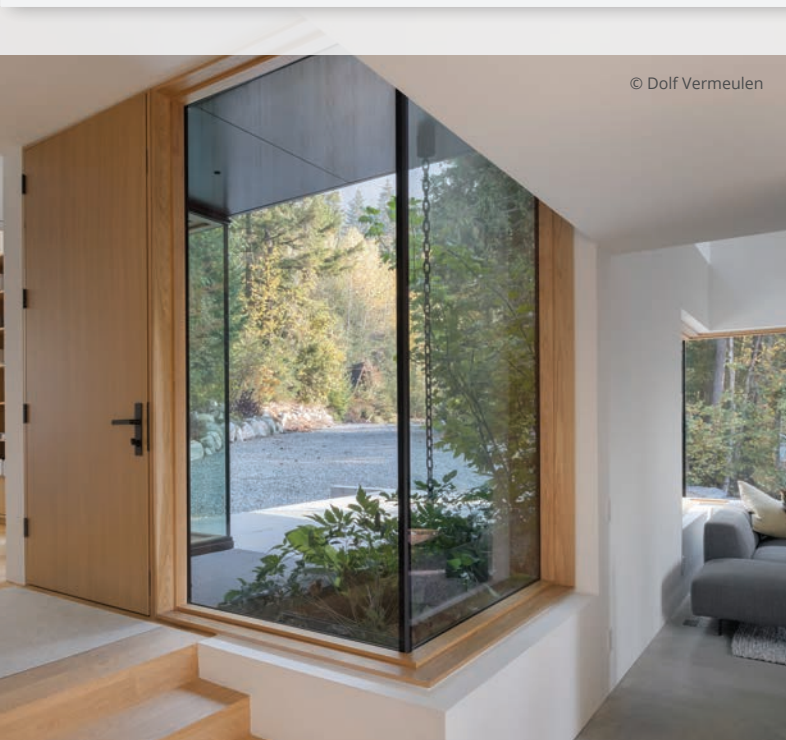




Direct Sets

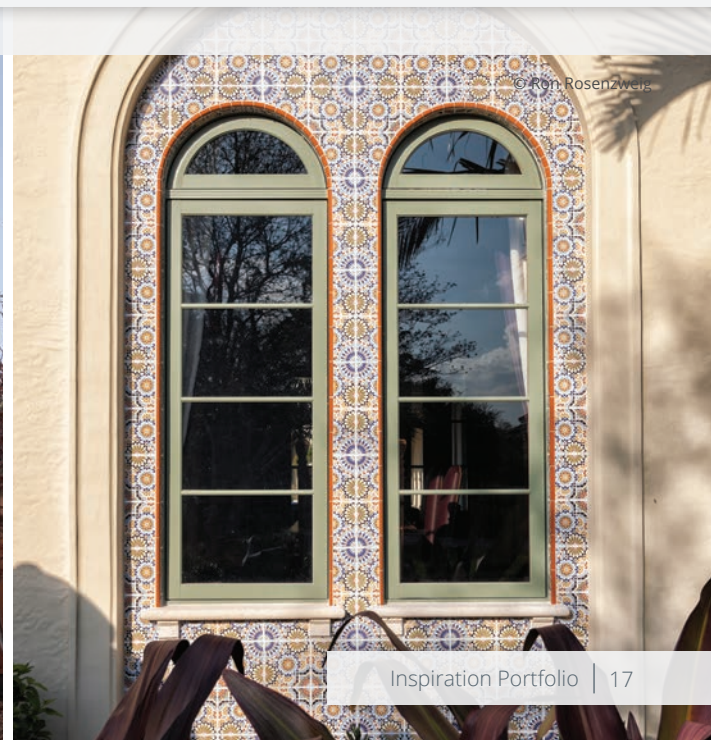
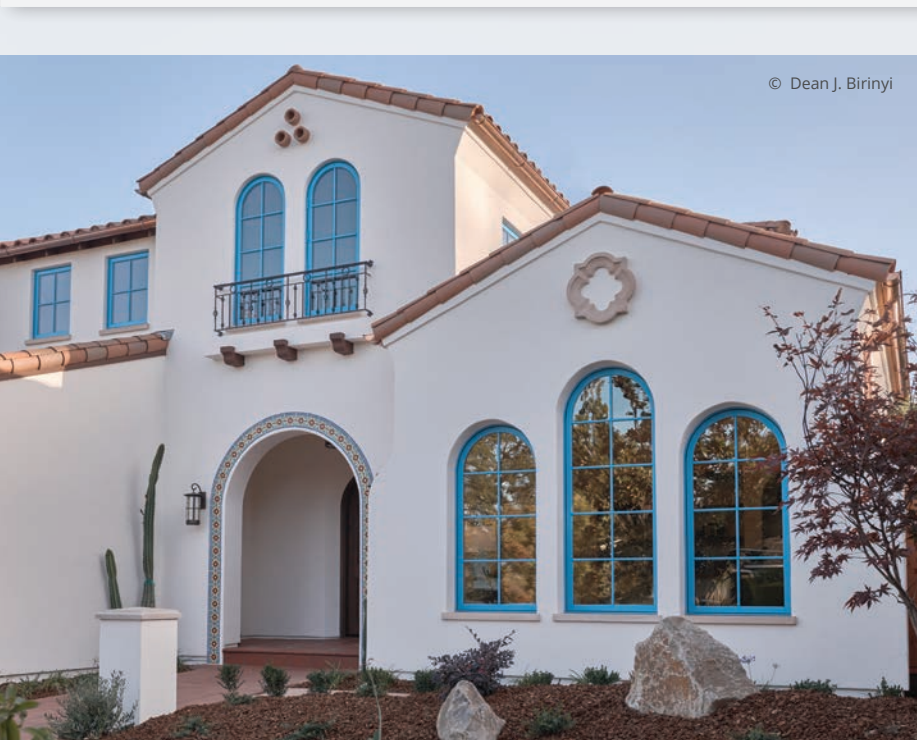




Radius Windows

Window Opening Control Device (WOCD)

Kolbe's WOCDs restrict the size of the open window area to less than 4 inches, and feature a limit release mechanism to allow for emergency escape. These devices allow the window to latch into place at a predetermined position and automatically re-latch when closed. Available for select double hungs, casements and sliding windows, WOCDs meet the ASTM F2090-13 requirements.

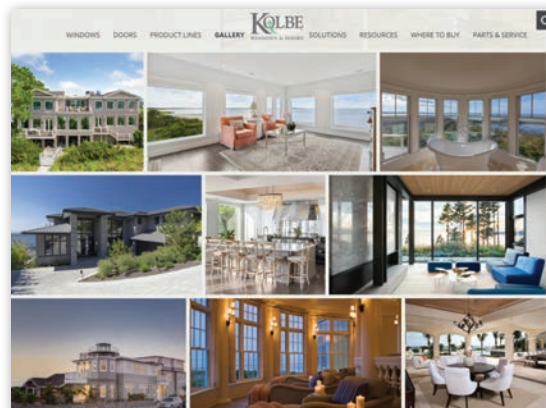
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
